Environmental Sustainability Statement.

We are music recognise that businesses can have a negative impact on the environment. We are committed, and try to find ways in which we can reduce the impact of our work. We are fortunate that we aren't required to purchase materials and that we don't produce much waste.

It is our policy to:

- Purchase all guitars and musical instruments second hand and repair and re-use our equipment.
- We use local labour and reclaimed materials wherever possible when working on our building. The building has boarded windows and at least 12" of insulation to minimise heat loss and to reduce noise from the building.
- Heating is only used in areas that are occupied and switched off when not in use. There is no overnight heating in the building and no electrical equipment is left on. Our total energy consumption is £1500 per annum.
- There is no parking on site and participants are encouraged to walk or arrive by public transport. Mentors and assistants share lifts to reduce fuel costs and parents are encouraged to form lift sharing groups to get youngsters to our centre.
- All correspondence is electronic we have no brochures or handouts, all teaching aids are online.
- To be aware of our environmental impact and to minimise it wherever possible.
